<b>“isolated nicotinamide riboside”</b>	'807 Patent: Claim 1	<b>“nicotinamide riboside that is separated or substantially free from at least some of the other components associated with the source of the nicotinamide riboside”</b>
<b>“the nicotinamide riboside is isolated from a natural or synthetic source”</b>	'807 Patent: Claim 2  '086 Patent: Claim 2	<b>“the nicotinamide riboside is isolated from a natural source or synthetic source and is not chemically synthesized”</b>
<b>“in combination with one or more of tryptophan, nicotinic acid, or nicotinamide”</b>	'807 Patent: Claim 1	<b>“both isolated nicotinamide riboside and one or more of tryptophan, nicotinic acid, or nicotinamide are found in the composition”</b>
<b>“increases NAD+ biosynthesis upon oral administration”</b>	'807 Patent: Claim 1	<b>“increases NAD+ biosynthesis upon oral administration to an animal relative to the level of NAD+ biosynthesis if the composition were not administered to an animal”</b>

<b>“pharmaceutical composition”</b>	'086 Patent: Claim 2	<b>“a composition that can be used to improve or prolong the health or well-being of humans or other animals”</b>
